#### Practice-

Practice in 8th grade math is graded upon completion. This means you have answered ALL questions and shown ALL of your work. Even if you have used a calculator to help you solve the problem it is important to write down what you type in. Students solving all problems and showing all work will receive a 100 and those who do not will receive a 0. This 0 cannot be corrected, replaced, or turned in late. At the beginning of each class answers will be shown so students can check their practice and see how they did so they can improve going forward.
